

Current Graduation/Completion and Transfer Rates — Student Right to Know Reporting for July 2009

Pima County Community College District is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion and transfer rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. The rates reflect the graduation, completion, and transfer status of students newly enrolled during the 2005-2006 school year and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-program completion (3 years) has elapsed.

During the fall semester 2005, 2,856 first-time, full-time, certificate-seeking or degree-seeking undergraduate students entered Pima County Community College District (PCC). After 3 years (i.e., as of June 30, 2008), 23% of these students had graduated from our institution and 8% had transferred to other public higher education institutions within Arizona.

Athletes Receiving Athletic-Based Financial Aid

During the 2005-2006 year, 79 first-time, full-time, certificate- or degree-seeking undergraduate athletes who received athletic-based scholarships enrolled at PCC. After 3 years, 32% of these athletes completed their programs, and 16% had transferred to other public higher education institutions within Arizona.
