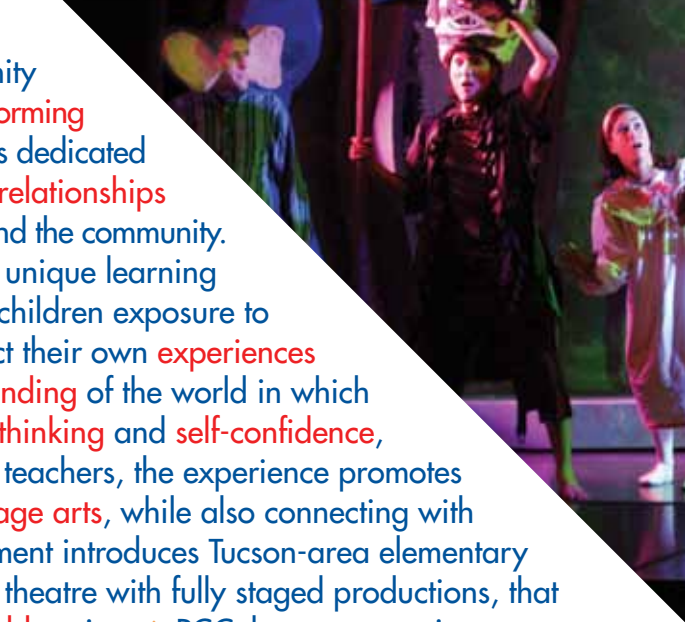

- ◆ The packets include fun activities to help teachers build lesson plans and curricular connections before and after the show.
- ◆ To maximize the theatre experience we also offer backstage tours and the opportunity to meet and interact with cast members.
- ◆ The children can also attend a free Saturday preview event with games, crafts and treats.
- ◆ In the past five years PCC theatre arts served 8,300 students and teachers from over 50 schools, with school matinee performances of *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, *James and the Giant Peach*, *Pippi Longstockings*, *The BFG* and *A Thousand Cranes*.
