The two types of programs also undergo different feasibility processes. It was agreed that if all the courses indicated in the degree were transferable, the faculty would prefer the Transfer classification. The program narrative will indicate that the student may also complete the program for direct employment. |
| Leadership Certificate (CRDLEADERSHP) | PASSED. Wording in the reason was questioned, and it was discovered that it was a typographical error. |

Dave Padgett brought a sample Program Completeness worksheet for discussion. The group requested that specific campus offerings not be indicated for students, just the district summary of offerings of each course. The group also agreed that indicating Day, Evening/Weekend, and Alternative (Online, Self-paced, and TBA) offerings was a good idea. Dave will be taking the worksheet to the DEG for discussion also before the curriculum office sends them out for the campuses to complete.

Dave also brought up that Transfer Programs will be assigned a lead campus to be responsible for program completeness. It's possible that the responsibility may switch between campuses from year to year. Kris White brought up the fact that the assignment of a lead campus should take the libraries into account to insure the texts are available at the campus. Another consideration is the existence of full-time faculty in the areas.
