The Governing Board delegates to the Chancellor or designee the authority and responsibility to endeavor to provide a safe and secure environment for the institution and its students, employees and visitors.

To promote a safe environment and to meet its formal statutory obligations and responsibilities for protecting the property, health, and safety of its students, employees and visitors, the College shall:

1. Employ police officers who have been certified as peace officers by the Arizona Peace Officer Standards and Training Board;
2. Provide appropriate security, protective service, health and public safety programs and activities;
3. Publish an Annual Security Report by October 1st in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act.
