Graduation/ Completion & Transfer Rates

May 2025/Cohort of Fall 2021

Pima County Community College District (PCC) provides the following information regarding our institution's graduation/ completion and transfer rates in compliance with the federal Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008. The rates reflect the graduation and transfer status of students newly enrolled at PCC during fall 2021 and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-program completion has elapsed.

In fall 2021, 855 first-time, full-time, certificate- or degree-seeking undergraduate students entered PCC. After 150% completion time had elapsed, 28% of these students had graduated from PCC and 16% had transferred to another institution of public higher education. This gives PCC a success rate of 44%.

Student-athletes Receiving Athletic-based Aid

During the 2021-2022 year, 37 first-time, full-time, certificate- or degree-seeking undergraduate student-athletes received athletic-based scholarships while enrolled at PCC.

Graduation and Transfer Rate by Sport, Race and Ethnicity, and Gender

The following table displays information on the graduation and transfer rates for various sports by gender and race/ethnicity groups.

After 150% completion time, 72% of first-time, full-time, certificate- or degree-seeking undergraduate student athletes completed their programs.
