SUMMER 2023 ENROLLMENT AND STUDENT CHARACTERISTICS EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report provides information about Pima Community College students who enrolled in credit classes at the end of the Summer 2023 term (99th day) and it contains summaries of headcount, enrollment, unofficial annual full-time student equivalent (FTSE), and section (CRN) count for the last five summer terms.

Tables and charts showing student enrollment are broken out by key demographics, including gender, full-time/part-time status, race/ethnicity, and students' age groups by each campus/location and division.

Pima Community College unduplicated head count in Summer 2023 was 8,043, up 7.7% from 7,465 in Summer 2022. Total annualized unofficial FTSE in Summer 2023 was 1,336 up 7.2% from 1,247 in Summer 2022. For the District, students enrolled were:

- 59.3% female (decreased 0.8% compared to Summer 2022)
- 2.8 % students were in enrolled in 12 or more credits (increased 0.2% compared to Summer 2022)
- 39.6% White, Non-Hispanic (increased 0.3% compared to Summer 2022)
- 43.5% Hispanic/Latino (decreased 0.1% compared to Summer 2022)
- 58.4% aged 18-24 (increased 1.0% compared to Summer 2022)

DEFINITIONS

The report includes all students who were enrolled on the last day of class, as well as students who withdrew after the add/drop date and received a "W" grade.

Headcount is unduplicated, meaning a student is counted only once within each breakdown category.

Enrollment or seatcount, is a student count for which a student is counted as many times as he/she is enrolled in any section within each breakdown category. Thus, this is a duplicated headcount.

Annualized unofficial FTSE is the total number of student term credit hours divided by 30.

A Full Time student is one who is enrolled in 12 or more credits within a specific term.

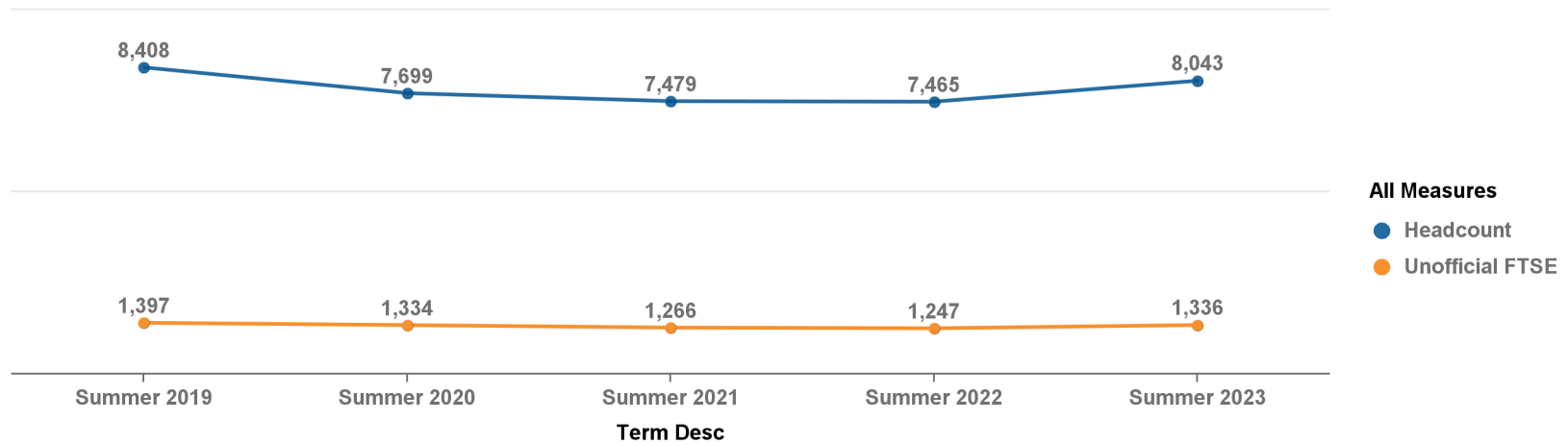

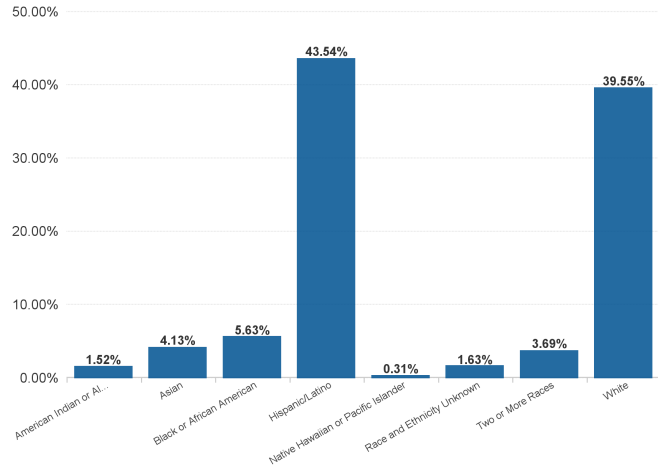

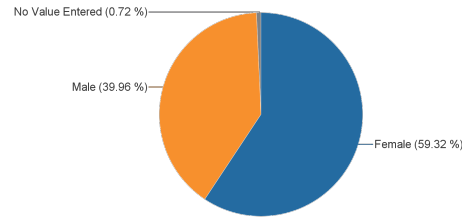

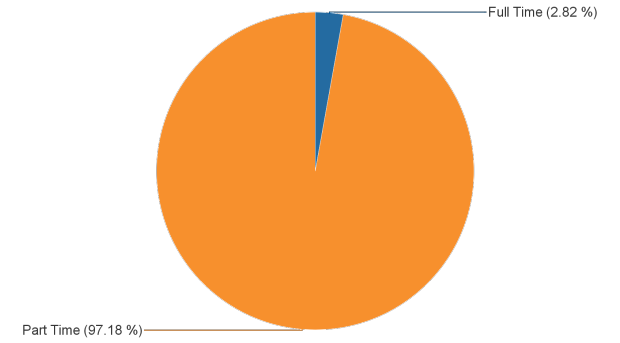
Summer 2023 -Headcount by Race/Ethnicity



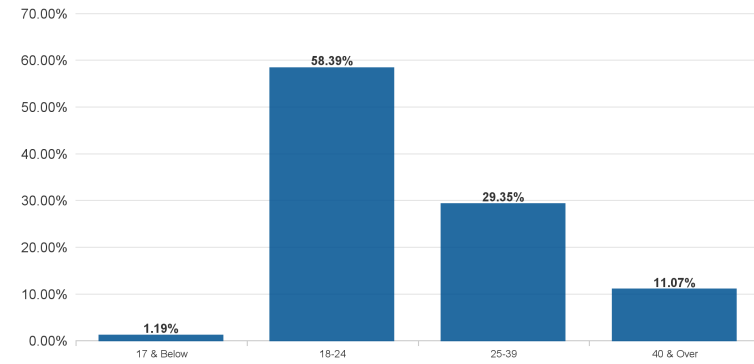
Summer 2023 -Headcount by Gender



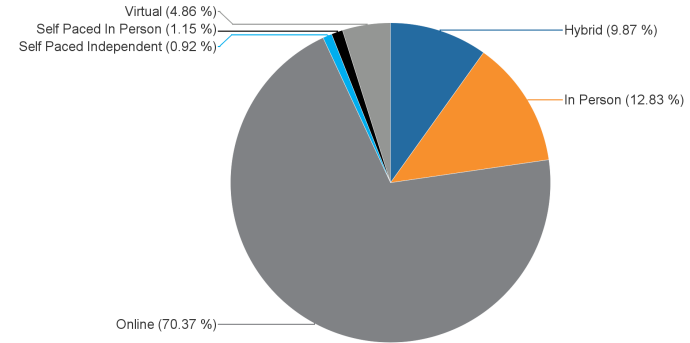
Summer 2023 -Headcount by FTPT Status



Summer 2023 -Headcount by Age Groups



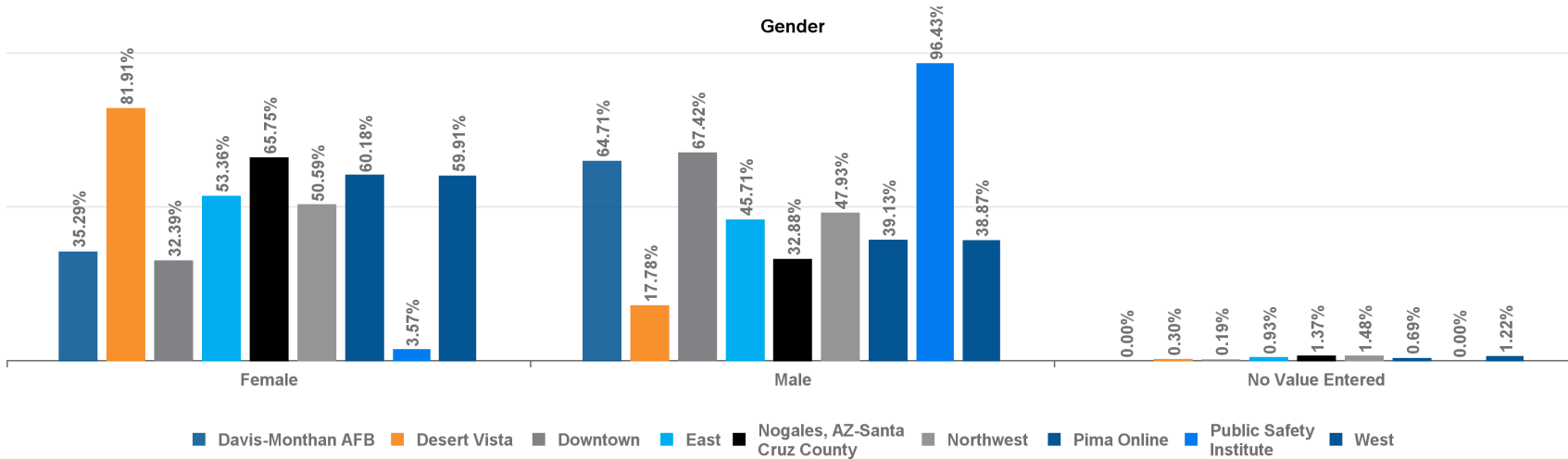
Summer 2023 -Enrollment by Modality

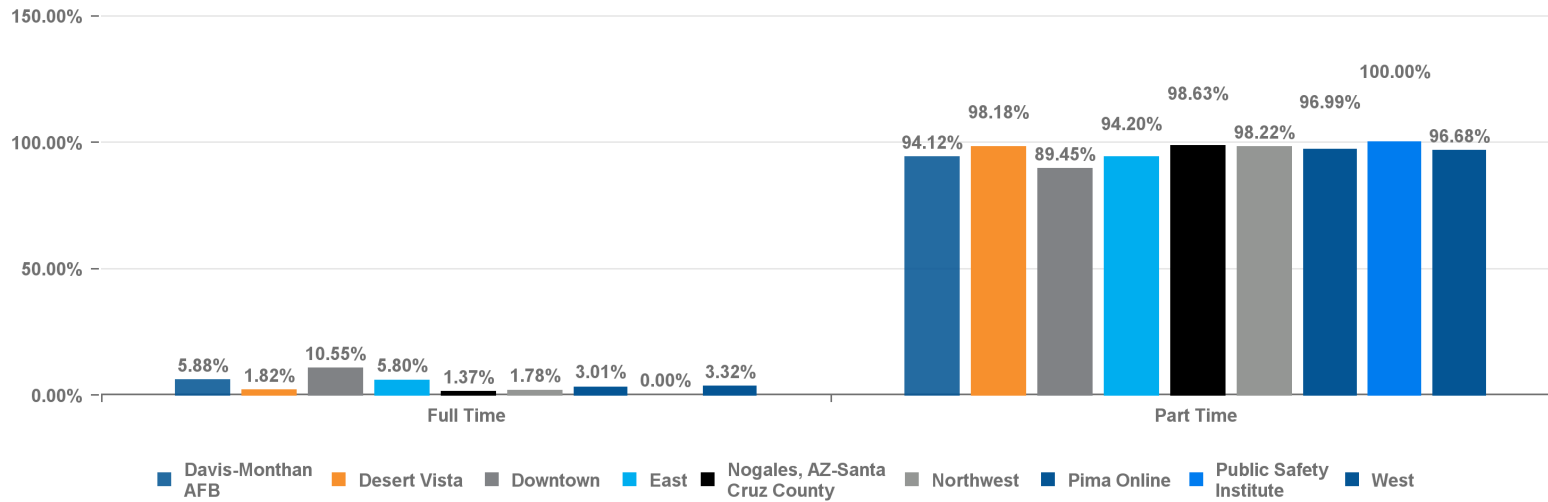

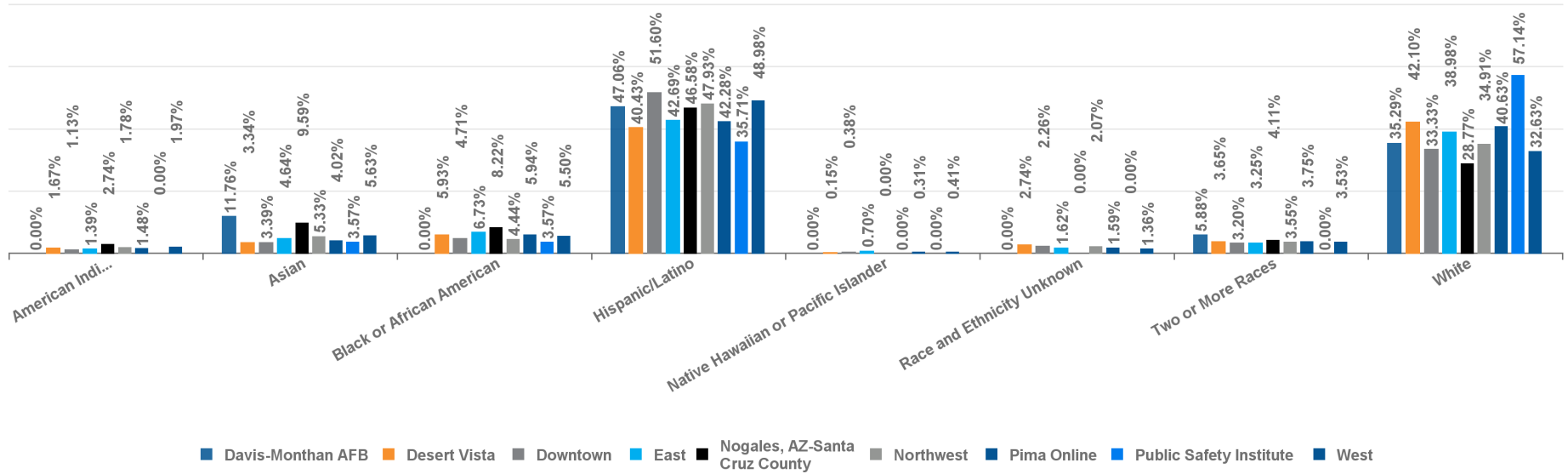

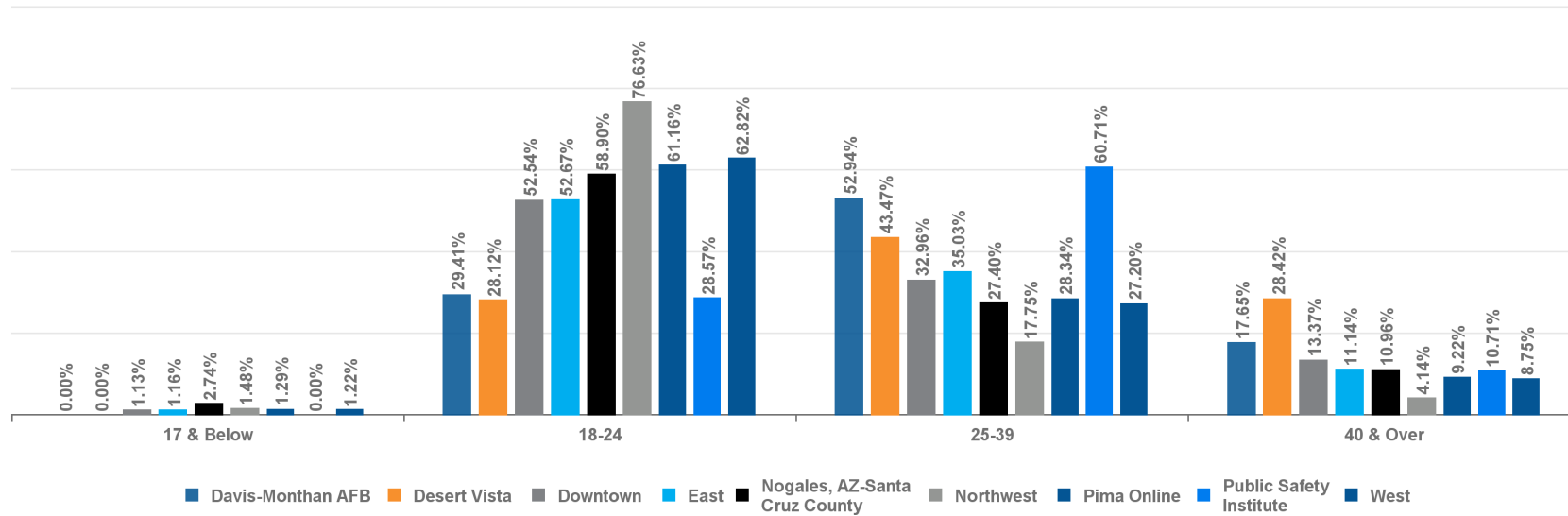

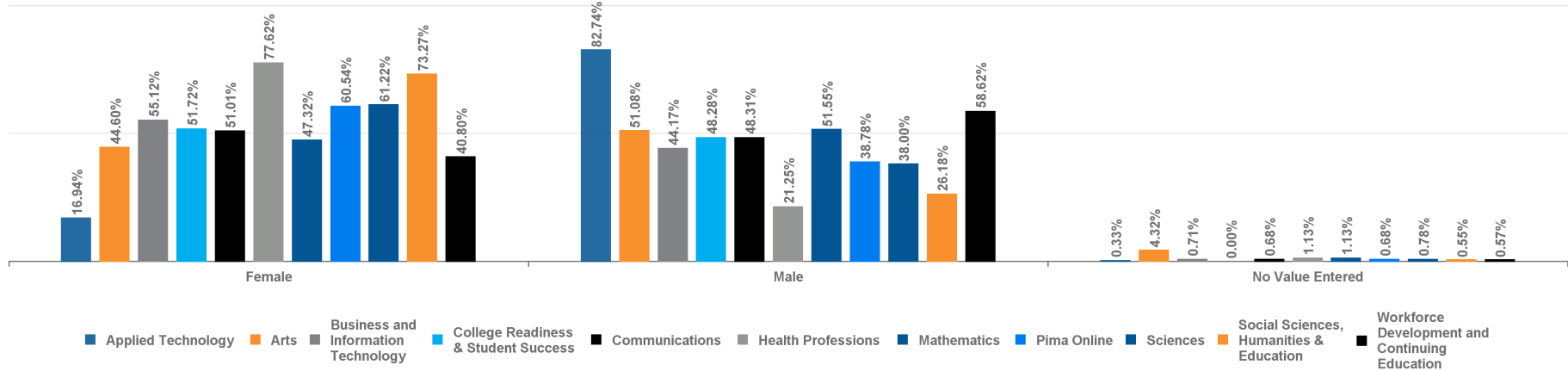

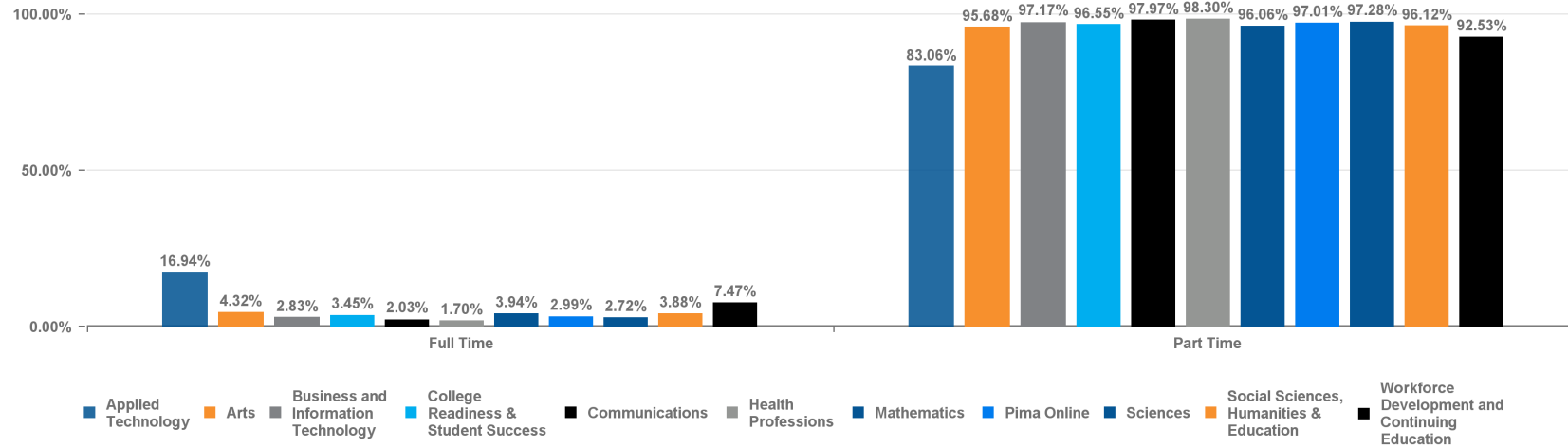

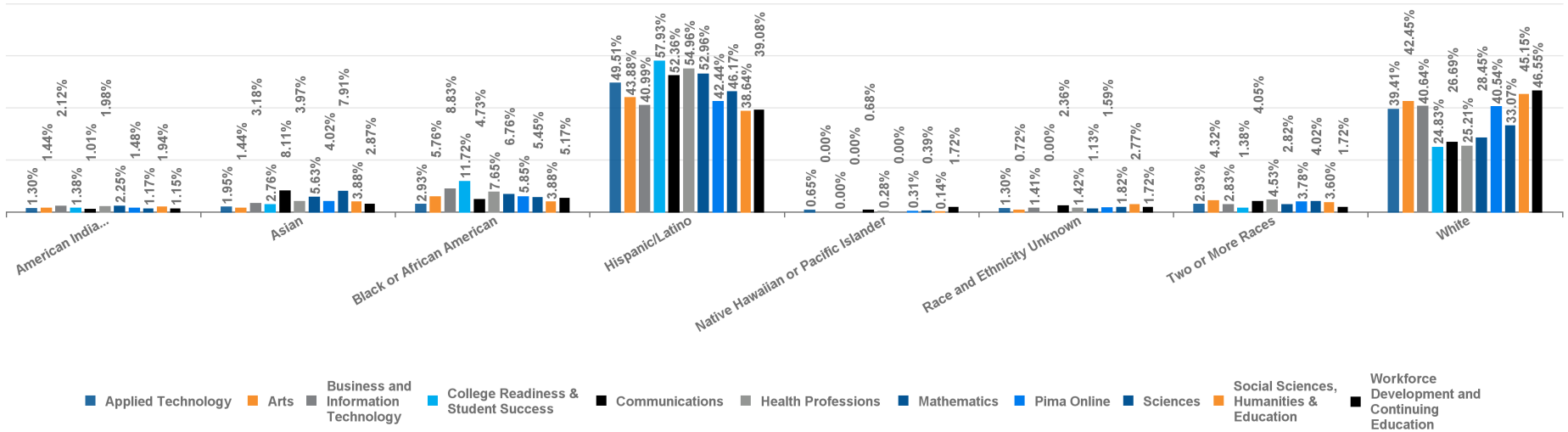
