# SPRING 2024 ENROLLMENT AND STUDENT CHARACTERISTICS EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report provides information about Pima Community College students who enrolled in credit classes at the end of the Spring 2024 term (99<sup>th</sup> day) and it contains summaries of headcount, enrollment, unofficial annual full-time student equivalent (FTSE), and section (CRN) count for the last five spring terms.

Tables and charts showing student enrollment are broken out by key demographics, including gender, full-time/part-time status, race/ethnicity, and students' age groups by each campus/location and division.

Pima Community College unduplicated head count in Spring 2024 was 16,522, up 4.4% from 15,830 in Spring 2023. Total annualized unofficial FTSE in Spring 2024 was 4,647 up 4.3% from 4,456 in Spring 2023. For the District, students enrolled were:

- 56.3% female (decreased 0.5% compared to Spring 2023)
- 29.6% students were enrolled in 12 or more credits (decreased 0.1% compared to Spring 2023)
- 36.7% White, Non-Hispanic (decreased 1.3% compared to Spring 2023)
- 47.9% Hispanic/Latino (increased 1.4% compared to Spring 2023)
- 56.4% aged 18-24 (decreased 0.4% compared to Spring 2023)

### **DEFINITIONS**

The report includes all students who were enrolled on the last day of class, as well as students who withdrew after the add/drop date and received a "W" grade.

Headcount is unduplicated, meaning a student is counted only once within each breakdown category.

Enrollment or seatcount, is a student count for which a student is counted as many times as he/she is enrolled in any section within each breakdown category. Thus, this is a duplicated headcount.

Annualized unofficial FTSE is the total number of student term credit hours divided by 30.

A Full Time student is one who is enrolled in 12 or more credits within a specific term.









#### Spring 2024 - Headcount by Gender
