

Community College Faculty Survey of Student Engagement (CCFSSE)

Spring 2014 Faculty and Student Frequency Distributions by Question

Summary

As described by the Center for Community College Student Engagement, the Community College Faculty Survey of Student Engagement (CCFSSE) "elicits information from faculty about their perceptions regarding students' educational experiences, their teaching practices, and the ways they spend their professional time—both in and out of the classroom. Offered as a companion to the Community College Survey of Student Engagement (CCSSE) student survey, CCFSSE is an online census survey that invites all faculty at participating colleges to contribute their front-line perspectives on student engagement. CCFSSE provides colleges with an effective way to invite faculty into a college-wide conversation about student engagement and success while spurring interest in their CCSSE survey results¹."

Pima Community College participated in both the CCSSE and CCFSSE surveys during the spring 2014 semester. The CCSSE was administered within a sample of face-to-face courses. The CCFSSE was administered online via an email invitation to participate by the Center for Community College Student Engagement (CCCSE) at The University of Texas at Austin. This invitation was sent to all Pima faculty and approximately 359 faculty members completed the survey. The CCFSSE contains approximately 55 questions, including the collection of demographic information, and took approximately 25-30 minutes to complete.

The following pages present the results of the CCFSSE along with the analogous questions posed to students in the CCSSE. CCCSE designs the two surveys partially as a means to compare faculty and student perceptions on different engagement topics and such questions are mapped to each other for reporting purposes. This report presents both faculty and student questions for the highest and lowest aspects of engagement and the associated responses to each. This report is also intended as a companion to the 2014 CCSSE Key Findings Report and intended to be utilized as information for continuously improving our services to both our current and future students.
