TIMELY WARNING

March 28, 2016

At approximately 6:15 p.m. this evening, a fight broke out between two males at the basketball courts located at the El Rio Neighborhood Center. The on-site security guard hired by PCC called Tucson Police Department when one of the male's retrieved a firearm and began shooting at the other male. Both males were gone from the area when police arrived. Pima College Police were notified of the incident at approximately 6:50 p.m. and had officers respond to the area to assist. Adult Education Center staff dismissed all classes while police were present. It is unknown if injuries were sustained by the fleeing male but no other parties were injured.

How to Protect Yourself: Avoid areas of confrontation and immediately report any possible violent incidents to 911. If you see someone in the area with a weapon or making threats leave immediately. If you are unable to leave, deny the threat access to your area. If you cannot avoid or deny the threat, be prepared to defend yourself, which you have the legal right to do.
