BAT: Behavioral Assessment Team

The Pima Community College Behavioral Assessment Team (BAT) is led by Police and Student Affairs Leadership committed to maintaining and improving College and community safety through a proactive, collaborative, objective and thoughtful approach to the identification and management of situations that pose, or may reasonably pose, a threat to the safety and well-being of the campus community.

When to report a concern:

- If you hear an explicit or implied threat of violence to any member of our community (or the public when on our campus). **CALL PCCPD 520-206-2700**
- Whenever you observe a student, employee or visitor exhibit behavior that can reasonably be interpreted as threatening.
- When you or your fellow students or co-workers express concern about safety in the workplace, classroom or anywhere on our campus.
