- Competition is open to any student enrolled in any Pima Community College course at any campus during Fall 2017 and/or Spring 2018.
- Work must have been completed during Fall 2017 or Spring 2018.
- Up to three pieces may be submitted. Media can be ceramics, digital, drawing, fibers, metals, mixed media, painting, photography, prints, sculpture, book arts and fashion design.
- All work must be ready to install and completely dry. Two-dimensional work needs to be ready to hang. **Wires or hanging brackets are required.** Work not containing wires or hanging brackets will not be juried.
- Artist information form should be attached on the back of the art.
- Artist agreement form needs to indicate fair market value and your signature is required.
- **All entries have to be delivered to the Louis Carlos Bernal Gallery during the following dates and times: March 19-22, from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. Call 206-6942 for special arrangements.**
- Students will be notified of acceptance by Monday, March 22.
- Artwork **not selected for exhibition** must be picked up March 26-29, 10 a.m.-5 p.m.
- Following the exhibition closing, artwork should be picked up from the Bernal Gallery May 7-10, 10 a.m.-5 p.m. Call 206-6942 for special arrangements.
