

Example: Jenna is an in-state student who will be enrolling for several classes in Spring 2012 semester:

STEP 1: Jenna enters the courses she plans to take and the credit hours for each course.

STEP 2: Next, she determines the type of tuition and places the credit hours in the correct column.

STEP 3: She totals the credits at the bottom of each column. Since she is an in-state student and is registering for Spring 2012 semester, she goes to the PCC web site and uses the Spring 2012 In-state Resident tuition schedule. She writes down the tuition for each category, and then adds them together to determine her estimated tuition cost.

STEP 1 Enter the courses that you plan to take and the number of credit hours for each course. Use Class Schedules for this information.		STEP 2 Determine the type of tuition charged for each course (General Tuition, Differential Tuition A or B). Put the number of credit hours for each course into the correct tuition column. Use Class Schedules for this information.
