You may also submit supporting legal documentation that describes your circumstance in lieu of such a statement. (Please provide this letter on letterhead.)

**Third-Party Substantiation – Personal:** Provide a supplemental letter from an adult or relative who has direct knowledge of your situation explaining your circumstance(s).
