Pima Community College students enrolled in classes at Davis-Monthan AFB

- All Pima students attending classes on Davis-Monthan AFB must show proof of U.S. Citizenship to enter the base. The only acceptable proofs of US citizenship are:
 1. original birth certificate; or
 2. U.S. passport, current or expired; or
 3. Naturalization papers for naturalized citizens.
- In addition, students driving vehicles onto the base must show their Pima class registration, driver's license, proof of auto insurance, and vehicle registration.
- Passes for entry onto the Base can be obtained at the Visitor's Center at Craycroft/Golf Links Gate, Mon.- Sat. between 7am-8pm.
- Students are encouraged to obtain base passes up to two weeks before classes start.
